**Welcome and Prayers.**

Rev. N Devenish opened the meeting with prayers and welcomed Dr R Baxter from Cartmel Priory to talk about the forthcoming celebrations to mark the 800<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the signing of the Magna Carta. Dr R Baxter gave a brief history of the Magna Carta and the key role played by William Marshall founder of Cartmel Priory. The Priory is planning a large celebration to mark the occasion from Friday 25<sup>th</sup> to Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> September. Events include a Flower Pageant, Medieval Festival, Concerts, Light Show and Services. Information sheets and posters were provided. A request for volunteers to help with the running of the celebrations was made, the PCC agreed to support the Priory with this.

**2. Mission Action Plan**

A long discussion took place over future implications of the Diocesan Strategy for Field Broughton church, Cartmel Priory and the Team as a whole.

- The Diocesan Strategy is moving ahead rapidly. It was reported from Team Council meeting that there was a suggestion/proposal by Team Rector that Field Broughton link with Finsthwaite, this had not mentioned to either PCC prior to Team Council meeting, the PCC did not wish to link with Finsthwaite.
- There appears to be clear agenda for one priest to oversee 10 churches run by lay people in the near future.
- There has been Anglican presence in Field Broughton since 1724 and PCC is committed to continue this. PCC's still have legal responsibility for their Parish.
- Diocesan Strategy is that PCC make own decisions on future of church taking into account views of congregation and wider community.
  
- The needs of our parish are not met by Diocesan Strategy.
